ADJOURNMENT

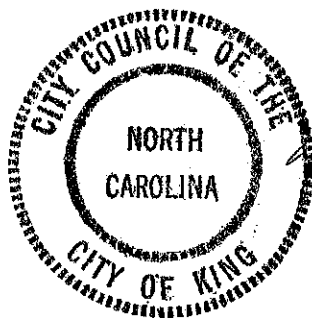
Councilwoman Cole motioned to adjourn the meeting. Councilwoman Fowler seconded the motion, which was carried by a unanimous vote of 3-0.


