



Veterans Memorial Order Form



What? - The City of King has embarked upon the construction of a veterans memorial at Central Park in King. In an effort to recognize our veterans and help in the construction cost we are selling commemorative quarry tiles that will recognize the veteran and the branch they served under. Each person who wishes to recognize a veteran would purchase a tile which would have the emblem of the branch of service under which the veteran served and would have the name of the veteran, status, date served, and either particular area or war that the veteran served in. In addition to the veterans being recognized on individual tiles those veterans killed in action will be recognized on a vertical granite surface on the memorial itself. The tiles will cost \$150.00 of which a portion goes for the cost of the tile and the remaining part goes towards the cost of the memorial.

Who? - Who can be recognized? Any veteran who has an honorable discharge from one of the five branches of service (Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines, or Coast Guard) and who has served from any period from World War I until present.

Where? - The memorial will be located in Central Park between the amphitheater and the newly constructed north parking lot off Kirby Road. The memorial will be a five sided structure with a reflect'g pool and fountains surrounded by an 1800 tile paver walkway with the veterans names listed.

When? - The city in conjunction with the American Legion Post 290 will be raising approximately \$90,000 in additional monies for the memorial through the sale of pavers. The final cost for the memorial is \$340,000 and new pavers will be dedicated on Nov. 11, 2008. Memorial pavers can still be purchased for \$150 and will be placed and dedicated each Veteran's Day in November until the memorial is full. At construction we had 1146 tiles purchased and approximately 400 blank pavers left to be sold as memorial pavers.
