The Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee met in a regular session via Zoom on Thursday, August 13, 2020. Present were: Lynn Barr, Cooper Smith, Chris Chunn, Steve Roberson, City Manager Homer Dearmin, and Parks and Recreation Director, Olivia Smith.

The overall costs of the potential project were discussed, including the amount of trees that might need to be removed from Central Park to construct a course.
