

**MINUTES
KING PARKS AND RECREATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE
REGULAR MEETING
THURSDAY, DECEMBER 8, 2022
6:00 P.M.**

The Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee met in a regular session on Thursday, December 8, 2022. Present were: Steve Roberson, Peggy Slate, Chris Chunn, Cooper Smith, and Parks and Recreation Director, Olivia Calloway.

Parks and Recreation Director, Olivia Calloway, called the meeting to order.

PUBLIC COMMENT

OLD BUSINESS

Chris Chunn made a motion to approve the minutes of the October 2022 regular meeting. Cooper Smith seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously with a 4-0 vote.

NEW BUSINESS

The committee discussed the ongoing Recreational Needs Survey, including current response levels (approximately 300 at time of meeting) and means for distributing.

The committee considered some of the outdated signage at Recreation Acres, brown signs that were installed when the park was renovated in 2003. These signs were determined to be an eyesore due to their condition and no longer necessary. Cooper Smith made a motion to recommend the Parks and Recreation department replace current signage with numbered signs on baseball fields and signs for restrooms. Steve Roberson seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously with a 4-0 vote.

Peggy Slate brought up a concern about the flooring on Everyone's Playground, which has holes in it that have been there for several months.
