

**MINUTES

**OLD BUSINESS**

Peggy Slate made a motion to approve the minutes of the December 2022 regular meeting, Chris Chunn seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously with a 4-0 vote.

**NEW BUSINESS**

Parks and Recreation Director, Olivia Calloway, informed the group of the status of the Rec Acres sports lighting upfit, including plans to apply for a NC Parks and Recreation Trust Fund grant to help cover the cost. The group discussed facilities that could be added to the grant proposal, and recommended adding rock dust and border timbers, as well as research into pricing of fitness equipment.

**ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS:**

Parks and Recreation Director Olivia Calloway updated the committee on park programming and maintenance, including cost information gathered by King Little League on the Field 6 building renovation. KLL proposed to hire a contractor to repair the existing building and asked that the City split the cost by reimbursing them for half of the cost. Steve Roberson made a motion to recommend splitting the Field 6 building renovation costs with King Little League. Peggy Slate seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously with a 4-0 vote.
