



City of King Notice of Public Hearing

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in accordance with the provisions of N.C.G.S. 159-12, the proposed budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020, for the City of King was deposited with the City Clerk and delivered to the Mayor and City Council on June 1, 2020 and due to the COVID-19 pandemic, is available for public inspection online at the City of King's website, found at www.ci.king.nc.us. As restrictions loosen, a hard copy is also available for public inspection in the King City Hall located at 229 South Main Street. The Budget Officer formally presented the budget message to the Mayor and City Council at the June 1, 2020, City Council meeting, held on June 1, 2020.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Special Meeting of the King City Council will be held in the Council Chambers at City Hall on June 18, 2020, beginning at 8:30 a.m., for the purposes of reviewing the proposed budget, scheduling a public hearing on the proposed budget, discussing COVID-19 emergency response and reopening plans, and taking up business tabled from the June 1, 2020 City Council meeting. A Public Hearing for the purpose of receiving input from citizens wishing to comment on the proposed City Budget for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 will be announced following the June 18 meeting. In order to comply with the Governor's Executive Order, both of these meetings will likely be limited to elected officials and staff, but will be broadcast via Zoom, with login and participation information published on the City's website and Facebook page when that information becomes available.
